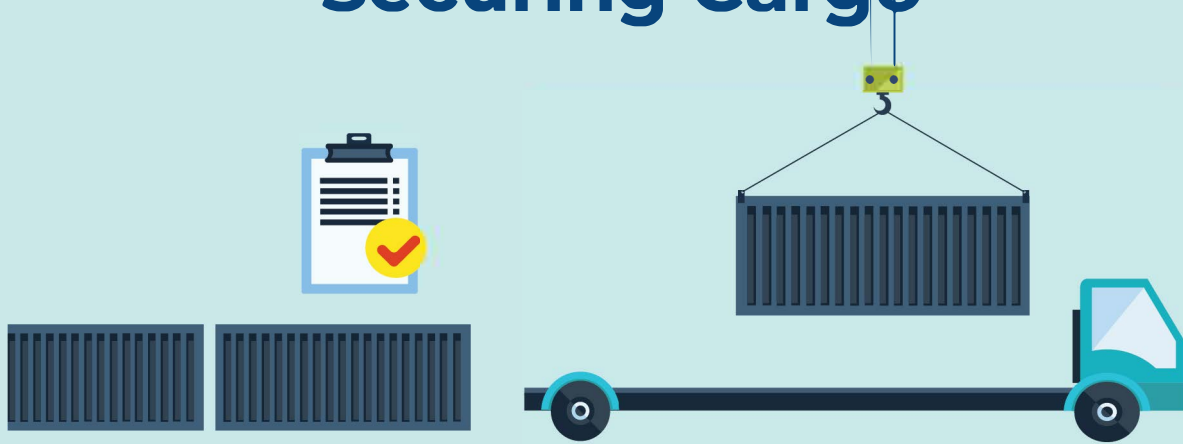


# Before Loading Cargo



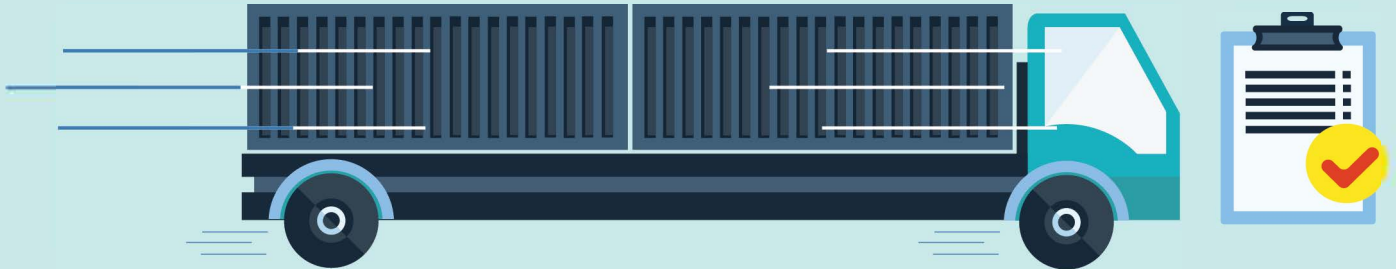
- The right vehicle
- Correct loading equipment and methods
- The best material to secure cargo
- The number of lashings or chains to best secure the cargo
- Ensure load platform and bodywork are clean

# Checklist While Loading and Securing Cargo



- Allowed vehicle weight and axle-load distribution
- Lighter goods at the top, heavier goods on bottom
- Loading cargo in accordance with the correctly planned unloading sequence
- No unnecessary space between cargo
- Securing materials are in good condition
- Securing arrangements should not damage cargo, and cargo should not damage securing arrangements
- Securing arrangements distribute weight evenly

# Checklist During the Journey



- Check cargo at periodic intervals
- If cargo is unloaded, redistributed, or loaded—recheck the cargo securing
- Drive safe and smoothly, without unexpected changes in direction and speed
- In case of emergency braking or direction change, check the cargo at the nearest stop
